WHAT IS P.A.D.?

As you know, our main source of income is
our weekly collection. In the past this was
sufficient to balance our annual budget, but
today, we are aware that for all kinds of good
reasons, it is not always possible for many of
you to be present every week. This is why
our collection drops considerably during the
summer months, holidays, spring breaks and
bad weather. Today, more and more
churches are relying on annual lump-sum
donations, weekly envelopes and pre-
authorized deposits.

As you may or may not know, St. Pat's has a
pre-authorized deposit (PAD) plan available
to parishioners. This format offers many
advantages and assures your church has a
steady cash flow all year round.

- You can provide regular on-going
support to St. Pat's,
- You automatically receive a year-end
receipt for tax purposes.
