HOW TO MAKE THE MOST OUT OF YOUR MASS

Try to be at Mass 15 minutes before it
begins to give yourself time to detach
from the stress of day to day living. Use
these few minutes to center yourself in
reflection.

SAYING AMEN

Amen is a word which comes from
Hebrew roots which signifies being firm,
solid, loyal. It evokes a wish or an
affirmation (it's true, I believe).
Christian tradition has kept this word,
which was used in the Jewish liturgies, to
express our full commitment to the faith.
Saying Amen refers us to Christ because
Amen is one of the names given to Christ
in the book of Revelation (REV 3:14).
Three important moments during the
Mass where Amen is significant:
Opening Prayers – responding Amen we
acknowledge the prayers proclaimed by
the celebrant.

Eucharistic Prayer – we respond Amen
to 'Through Him, With Him and In
Him', without doubt, this is the most
solemn response in the celebration.

Communion – is an individual and
communal action. In responding Amen,
we proclaim our faith in Christ but also
our desire to become part of the body of
Christ.
