THE AMBO (THE PULPIT)

In a church, the Ambo is where we
proclaim the Word of the Lord. It is a
raised pulpit which permits the assembly
to see and clearly hear the Lector. To
show the importance that we give to the
Word of God, its placement should
spontaneously attract the attention of the
faithful. As indicated by the Book of
Blessings, the Ambo should appear to
everyone "as a sign of the table of the
Word of God, which is the primordial
and necessary food for the life of
Christians". It should be the place
where the word of the Son resounds and
where those who hear the Word obey the
Spirit who invites them to put the Word
into practice.

On our Ambo, you will notice the Cross,
the focus of the Word, which is
surrounded by four symbols representing
the evangelists (writers of the gospels).
They are Matthew, Mark, Luke and
John.
