On the fourth Sunday of Easter, called  
“Good Shepherd Sunday,” we are invited  
to pray for vocations to the priesthood in  
a very special way. As Christ himself  
wished, and as the Church has always  
understood and taught, there can be no  
Catholic Church, without priests. In the  
name and the person of Christ the Head  
of the Church, priests alone can preside  
at the Eucharistic celebration, ‘the fount  
and apex of the whole Christian life’, as  
the Second Vatican Council states  
clearly. Only priests can pardon sins and  
reconcile the faithful with God and the  
Church; only they can administer the  
sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick  
for those who are ill.  
We pray for these vocations because we  
believe that the priesthood, as Christ  
instituted it, is necessary.
