SUNDAY OF THE WORD

Much more than a book! A LIVING WORD!

This is the title we find on the poster prepared by the Diocese of Valleyfield for the Sunday of the Word which, this year, is celebrated on January 26, 2020. Even though we listen to the Word every Sunday, Pope Francis established the third Sunday of Ordinary Time as the Sunday of the Word to allow "the Church to revive the gesture of the Risen One who also opens for us the treasure of his Word so that we may be heralds in the world of this inexhaustible wealth" (Apostolic Letter *Aperuit Illis*, n. 2).

Much more than a book, the Word of God is life: it is vital to nourish our personal and community relationship with the Lord. It is indispensable for fulfilling our responsibility as baptized and as disciple-missionaries. It can only lead us towards Christian unity. And in keeping with our pastoral theme "With charity we're stepping out!", the Word of God is able to open our eyes to enable us to come out of the individualism that leads to asphyxiation and sterility, while opening wide the way to sharing and solidarity" (Apostolic Letter *Aperuit Illis*, n. 13).

Let us therefore take advantage of this Sunday to value the Word of God in our Christian communities so that it may become ever more a source of life and light on our path, every day and every Sunday of the year.
