## OUR LENTEN JOURNEY

5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent  
THE POWER OF SILENCE

Central Message: On many occasions, Jesus insisted on the mercy of God. No story is more touching than the story of the adulteress who stands alone before her accusers. Jesus' silence completely disarms her accusers.

1st Reading: Isaiah 43: 16-21  
The prophet asks us not to be attached to the past, but to look to the present where God is making all things new.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Philippians 3:8-14  
True justice is the knowledge of Christ based on faith.

Gospel: John 8:1-11  
Jesus refuses to condemn the adulteress and invites her to take a different path, and to enter a new life.

Question to Ponder This Week:  
What helps me to have confidence in life?  
What memory nourishes my hope and keeps me going with Christ?
