**SUNDAY REFLECTION**

On the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent, Matthew shows us Jesus as he relives Israel's journey in the desert, which Matthew remembers as a time of purification of God's people, like gold tested in fire; each one of Jesus' responses to the enemy is a citation from Deuteronomy 6-8, when Moses rehearses and interprets for the people the meaning of their years of desert wandering. Jesus comes thru the trials and shows himself to be faithful Israel, God's son, and thus a true teacher of Torah.

Perhaps we can enter into Lent this year in this spirit of going deeper and making our life of faith more interior. Beyond whatever Lenten practice, good as it may be for us, we can turn to Jesus who nourishes us from the rich root of God's promises to his people, and allow him to show us the deeper meaning of our own sacred history with its many desert wanderings, so as to know better our vocation to be a light in the sight of all.
