REFLECTION

Peter talks about his experience with the
Gentiles (non-Jews), and "all that God
had done with them." Sometimes we
forget that salvation is free and all-
inclusive. In order to be saved, all we
need to do is to love God and our peers.
This love presupposes that we will not
hate, hurt, or harm.

I remember a sister in the church who
was troubled because she had read a
biblical passage instructing women to
cover their heads. It seems to me this is
a problem of reading scripture without
knowing its context. I simply replied to
her, "Whoever wants to cover their head,
let them do it!" I do not think covering
one's head is intrinsically good or bad. I
have a hard time imagining God asking
me for an account of whether I covered
my head or not. I think God is more
likely to ask me, "My daughter, how
much did you love others? How much
did you harm them? How much did you
help others? To whom did you lend a
hand?"
