REFLECTION

For Sunday August 27th:

In this Gospel, we see grace operating in
Peter's heart as he realizes Jesus is the
Son of God. When we reflect on our
own lives, we can certainly pinpoint such
moments. Moments where God makes
clear to us deep truths that we were once
unable to grasp. "For flesh and blood
has not revealed this to you, but my
Father in heaven." We must never forget
that our faith is a gift; it is infused into
our souls by Christ himself. It is not
something we figured out on our own.

We all have loved ones who just don't
seem to get it, who either don't believe
or don't practise their faith, and we often
ask, why? It is tempting to become
frustrated with loved ones who have
fallen away – to turn away from them –

disciples as they work through their
