REFLECTION

“Good Morning. This is God. I will be handling all your problems today. I will not need your help. So, relax and have a great day.”

These word hung on the door of my grandmother’s assisted living apartment. She saw them each time she left her private unit. When I visited her, I read those words too. They offered a sense of comfort to me, and I imagine my grandmother also felt reassured by these words and the feeling that God would be with her throughout the day.

The door sign was my grandmother’s version of a mezuzah, the blessing box by the door of Jewish homes as a reminder of God’s constant presence. It is easy to become overwhelmed with all we need to accomplish in a given day and not appreciate each day for what it is - a gift.
