REFLECTION

The exchange of peace is a moment of
connection, a visible, tangible reminder
that we do not worship alone. It can also
be a time of reconciliation.

Too often we regard the exchange of
peace as “intermission” in the service or
a time to socialize with friends, but there
is a much deeper significance to this part
of the liturgy. As we transition from the
Word to the Altar within the service, we
share the peace of God with one another,
a sign of reconciliation and a way to
prepare our hearts for Eucharist.

During COVID-19 pandemic, the hugs
and handshakes of peace were replaced
with head nods, fist bumps or peace
fingers. I missed the tactile aspect of
exchanging peace, but maybe the
outward gestures are not as important as
the inner desire to seek and share God’s
peace.
