REFLECTION

*Matthew 13:45a – The kingdom of
heaven is like a merchant.*

The parables of the treasure in the
field and of the pearl of great price
are placed in such a way that a
careless or inattentive reader might
assume the pearl, like the treasure,
refers to the Reign of God. But look
again: “the kingdom of heaven is like
a merchant in search of fine pearls”
(emphasis added). What, then, does
the spectacular pearl signify? In a
word: US. In the previous parable,
the man is enriched by finding the
kingdom. In the second, the
kingdom is enriched by finding us.
We are the pearl of great value. It is
for us that God gives everything.
