SUNDAY REFLECTION

Come Lord, Show us the Way!
Wednesday, we are invited to embark on a journey that will lead to Easter. During this past Advent, we have cried out: "Come Lord, show us your face". During the coming Lent, we implore the Lord to "show us the way". The road forward seems blocked; so many potholes, so many detours, so many dead ends. It is not surprising that we feel lost. Lent is an occasion to discover the right road forward to a deeper relationship with the Lord.
