SUNDAY REFLECTION

Philippians 3:13-14. Beloved, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but this is one I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

The Apostle Paul reminds us in this passage about the importance of forgetting what is behind and pressing forward. Through repentance and forgiveness, we can learn from our mistakes and move forward with a renewed sense of purpose.
