SUNDAY REFLECTION

Philippians 4:6. Do not be worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made know to God.

This verse gives us a powerful reminder to turn to God when we feel anxious and overwhelmed. Anxiety can be all-consuming, making it difficult to focus on anything other than worries and fears. It can leave us feeling helpless and alone. But in this verse, Paul encourages us to bring our anxieties to God through prayer and petition.

Furthermore, Paul instructs us to approach God with thanksgiving. Amid our anxieties, it can be easy to forget about the blessings in our lives. However, giving thanks to God can shift our perspective and help us see the good that is present even in difficult times.

I have found that practicing gratitude is a powerful antidote to anxiety. Gratitude and mindfulness help me foster a sense of peace and contentment, allowing me to trust more fully in God's plan for my life.
