SUNDAY REFLECTION

Mark 14:19. They began to be distressed
and to say to him one after another,
“Surely, not I?”

After Jesus declares that someone will
betray him, the disciples revert to self-
preservation instead of expressing
concern for Jesus' safety. The disciples'
ongoing ignorance about what is taking
place is shocking and heartbreaking.

Herein lies the dilemma of our present
reality. As much as we think we know
what is happening, there is always more
to the story. I believe one of the reasons
Jesus invites the disciples to stay awake
and pray is so they have time to discern
the meaning behind the events taking
place. Sadly, they do not follow what he
asks.

The times we live in are tumultuous,
with many experiencing extreme
challenges. Our leaders often rush
toward quick solutions when real
societal solutions require transformation
of the heart. How might we express
genuine concern for those needing our
help instead of defaulting to old patterns
of self-preservation? Our discipleship
might put the concerns of Christ over
our own for the benefit of all.
