The Psalms are a collection of 150 prayers for all occasions that have been recited by believers for over three thousand years, especially by Jesus, and are still used today. At each Mass one is said to praise the Lord. All are invited respond out loud. The response is meant to help us understand the readings and of the Gospel.
