REFLECTION

Mark 4:39a. (Jesus) woke up and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace! Be Still!"

Jesus is speaking to the wind when he says, "Peace! Be still!" But we might imagine that these words could also be directed to the disciples who have whipped themselves into a frenzy.

Sometimes our inner storms are violent, or more violent, than the circumstances outside. We ride the wave of emotions and at our worst moments, the emotional waves ride us. There is even a new word out there for our capacity to create storms within us: "catastrophize." We can make a situation seem worse than it might be. Faith invites us to put situations in perspective and to trust that God will be with us in every storm.
