REFLECTION

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.
The heart of Jesus is adored as a symbol of His threefold love: human, spiritual and divine. In the Old Testament, this love is described as a father's love for his children or a husband's love for his wife. In the New Testament, the promise of living water, the Holy Spirit, is fulfilled in the pierced heart of the Messiah. Our modern understanding of the Sacred Heart of Jesus has been shaped by the visions experienced by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. In modern times, the image of the Sacred Heart in the home has become a sign that the love of Jesus rules over the family. In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
